Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the above listed project. We have reviewed the EAW pursuant to the responsibilities given to the Minnesota Indian Affairs Council by the Private Cemeteries Act (MS 307.08), and the Minnesota Field Archaeology Act (MS 138.31-.41). Although there is no recorded archaeological site with in the area of the proposed Processing Facility we are concerned with the project because of its proximity to the Water Tank Mound site (21GD0042). Adding to our concern is the fact that the storm water ponds for the project are in the planned laydown area within the boundaries of the mound/cemetery site. Given that 21GD0042 is protected under the Private Cemeteries Act (MS 307.08) any development or construction activities are not permitted within the site boundaries without direct consultation with the Office of the State Archeologist and our office.
