## Relevant Statutes and Rules

- Certificate of Need
  - Minn. Stat. 216B.243
  - Minn. Rule 7849
- Site Permit
  - Minn. Stat. 216E

Both permit procedures may be conducted in sequence or jointly (if filed at same time).

#### Certificate of Need Process Chart for Large High **Voltage Transmission Facilities**

Applicant provides notice of intent to file application to potentially affected persons

Applicant submits application to the Public Utilities Commission and distributes to interested persons.

Public Utilities Commissions refers case to Independent Office of Administrative Hearings for a contested case hearing

Administrative Law Judge conducts public hearings and assembles facts of the

Administrative Law Judge prepares report with Findings of Fact, Conclusions, and Recommendations

Public meeting is held in project area to receive comments on scope of Environmental Report

Department of Commerce commissioner determines the scope of Environmental Report

Department of Commerce prepares Environmental Report

Public Utilities Commission grants or denies Certificate of Need
