Dear Mr. Dorsett:

On March, 5, 2013 the Midwest Independent Transmission System Organizer, Inc. submitted a Notice of Termination for the Interconnection Agreement relating to Project G519.<sup>1</sup>

Your filing was noticed in the *Federal Register* with comments, protests, or motions to intervene due on or before March 26, 2013. Under 18 C.F.R. § 385.210, interventions are timely if made within the time prescribed by the Secretary. Under 18 C.F.R. § 385.214, the filing of a timely motion to intervene makes the movant a party to the proceeding, if no answer in opposition is filed within fifteen days. MISO Transmission Owners and ALLETE, Inc. filed timely comments in support of the filing.

Pursuant to the authority delegated to the Director, Division of Electric Power Regulation - Central, under 18 C.F.R. § 375.307 of the Commission's Regulations, your filing is conditionally accepted effective, May 4, 2013 as requested.
