JUDGE HEYDINGER: Citizens Energy Task 1 2 Force. MS. MACCABEE: Paula Maccabee for 3 Citizens Energy Task Force. 4 5 JUDGE HEYDINGER: For the Department of 6 Commerce, Office of Energy Security. MS. ANDERSON: Julia Anderson. Also with 7 me is Dr. Steve Rakow. 8 9 JUDGE HEYDINGER: And for the staff 10 today. 11 MR. JACOBSON: David Jacobson. Bob Cupit 12 will be in and out, and also Andrew Mensing. 13 JUDGE HEYDINGER: Thank you. All right. 14 We have had some revised maps distributed to the 15 parties summarizing Mr. Krikava's explanation 16 yesterday, and we'll give the parties all an 17 opportunity to look at those. And later this 18 morning, perhaps after the first break, we'll see if 19 there are any additional questions about them and at 20 that time we will have them marked for 21 identification and determine whether there are any 22 objections to having them received into the record. 23 Are there any other preliminary matters 24 before we continue with the cross-examination by No

MR. KRIKAVA: I have one, Your Honor.

JUDGE HEYDINGER: Mr. Krikava.

MR. KRIKAVA: Thank you. Your Honor, for the record, I would like to reflect that

Ms. Overland, on behalf of No CapX, has put on the Elmo projector the Mid-Continent Area Power Pool System Map, known as the MAPP map. It's not my document. It's not my issue. But I would point out that that -- it's our understanding that the MAPP map is classified under federal law as critical energy infrastructure information that is not to be disclosed on a public basis and you have to sign a nondisclosure agreement to receive it.

I know, for example, that the MCEA in discovery in this matter asked us for a copy of the MAPP map and we went through all sorts of wrangling, and I think, Mary, we never did end up giving it to you. You guys withdrew the request, if I'm remembering right.

But anyway, I just want the record clear that that document is not being sponsored by Applicants. It's not been disclosed publicly by Applicants.

MS. OVERLAND: Your Honor, I wish to address that.

1 JUDGE HEYDINGER: Ms. Overland. MS. OVERLAND: This is a 2005 map, long 2 3 before the CEII came into play. I've had this for 4 years. 5 JUDGE HEYDINGER: Mr. Krikava, do you care to respond to that? 6 7 MR. KRIKAVA: I have nothing further, 8 Judge. Thanks. 9 JUDGE HEYDINGER: All right. Well, I 10 must admit, I'm not familiar with the legal status 11 of this map, Ms. Overland. Can you be clear for the 12 record from whom or where you obtained it? 13 MS. OVERLAND: I'm trying to remember. 14 I've been in so many transmission proceedings I 15 can't remember exactly where it came from. 16 think it came from -- I've got a number of copies. 17 I can look at the properties and see who sent it to 18 me, but I've had it since 2005. It's a 2005 update 19 of a 2004 map. There's also a new 2007 map which I 20 don't have. 21 JUDGE HEYDINGER: Well. here's --22 MS. OVERLAND: And that will be covered 23 under CEII. This is something that they just 24 instituted within the last six months or so. 25 this is an old map.

JUDGE HEYDINGER: Well, I understand that, but I don't know for certain what its legal status is. I would appreciate it if before we add it into the record of this case, which would then involve having it scanned and posted on a public web site, that we verify what its status is and ensure that it can in fact be disseminated to the public.

MS. OVERLAND: Your Honor, it already is public. And I presented it at the -- it would have been -- I think it was the 2006 Power Plant Siting Act. Mr. Cupit may remember. I presented it and we drew in the CapX lines at that time and put power plants in at that time. It's a public record then, it's posted on my blog, public there. This was present before it ever came into being. This is not the map covered by the CEII. It's the most recent I had discovered. You can't retroactively cover the documents, they are already in the public domain.

JUDGE HEYDINGER: That's certainly true.

Well, I will take you at your word. I have no other basis --

MS. OVERLAND: I know that I was at the power plant siting hearing and entered it into the report. I'm sure Mr. Cupit remembers my drawing those lines on the map.

JUDGE HEYDINGER: Your point is it's already in the public domain.

MS. OVERLAND: It's already in the public domain. It's on my blog. You can look at it online anytime you like at legalelectric.org.

JUDGE HEYDINGER: That's fine. Is there anyone else who cares to comment concerning the public status of this particular document?

All right. Anything additional? And does the staff care to comment at all about the status of this map? Mr. Cupit.

MR. CUPIT: Bob Cupit. For the record, my recollection is that it was submitted as an exhibit in the public hearing on the power plant siting program and that it is an attachment in the docket that is online. I believe it did have some markings on it that showed some potential coal plants, I believe, or some type of generation plants. But subject to check that this map is indeed the same map, I would agree that there was a map, it appears to be the same one that's in that record.

JUDGE HEYDINGER: All right. With that understanding, we'll proceed.
