- Leadership from DEED, Commerce, Agriculture, EQB and others
- Goal is to better integrate economic development and energy policy strategies



NGA Project Scope

- Focus on 5 sectors:
 - Wind
 - Solar
 - Energy Efficiency
 - Bioenergy
 - Smart grid/new technologies
- Consider entire value chain R&D, manufacturing, sales, installation, support services, etc.



NGA Asset Mapping

- Help meet goals of creating jobs, keeping energy dollars in the state
- Build network for businesses
- Help existing companies grow
- Understand, predict and plan for workforce demands, training needs



NGA Industry Engagement

- Survey of businesses for clean energy economic analysis underway now
- Five sector roundtable meetings this month
- Clean Energy Economy Summit
 - July 17, University of Minnesota
- Recommendations to Governor in September



Minnesota Renewable Integration Technical Study

- 2013 legislation directed Minnesota utilities to study grid impacts/reliability issues in moving to higher penetration levels (40% by 2030)
- Study team comprised of utility engineers, national experts working under Commerce direction
- Study results due in November, 2014
