A bill for an act
relating to energy; abolishing prohibition on issuing certificate of need for new
nuclear power plant; amending Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 216B.243,
subdivision 3b.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MINNESOTA:

Section 1. Minnesota Statutes 2014, section 216B.243, subdivision 3b, is amended to
read:

Subd. 3b. ~~Nuclear power plant; new construction prohibited; relicensing~~
Additional storage of spent nuclear fuel. (a) The commission may not issue a certificate
of need for the construction of a new nuclear-powered electric generating plant:

~~(b) Any certificate of need for additional storage of spent nuclear fuel for a facility~~
seeking a license extension shall address the impacts of continued operations over the
period for which approval is sought.

EFFECTIVE DATE. This section is effective the day following final enactment.
