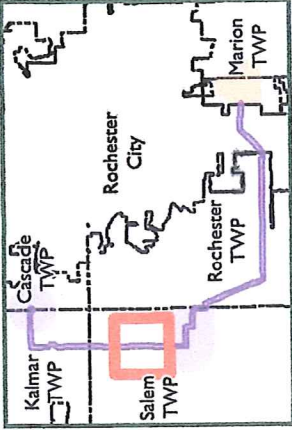
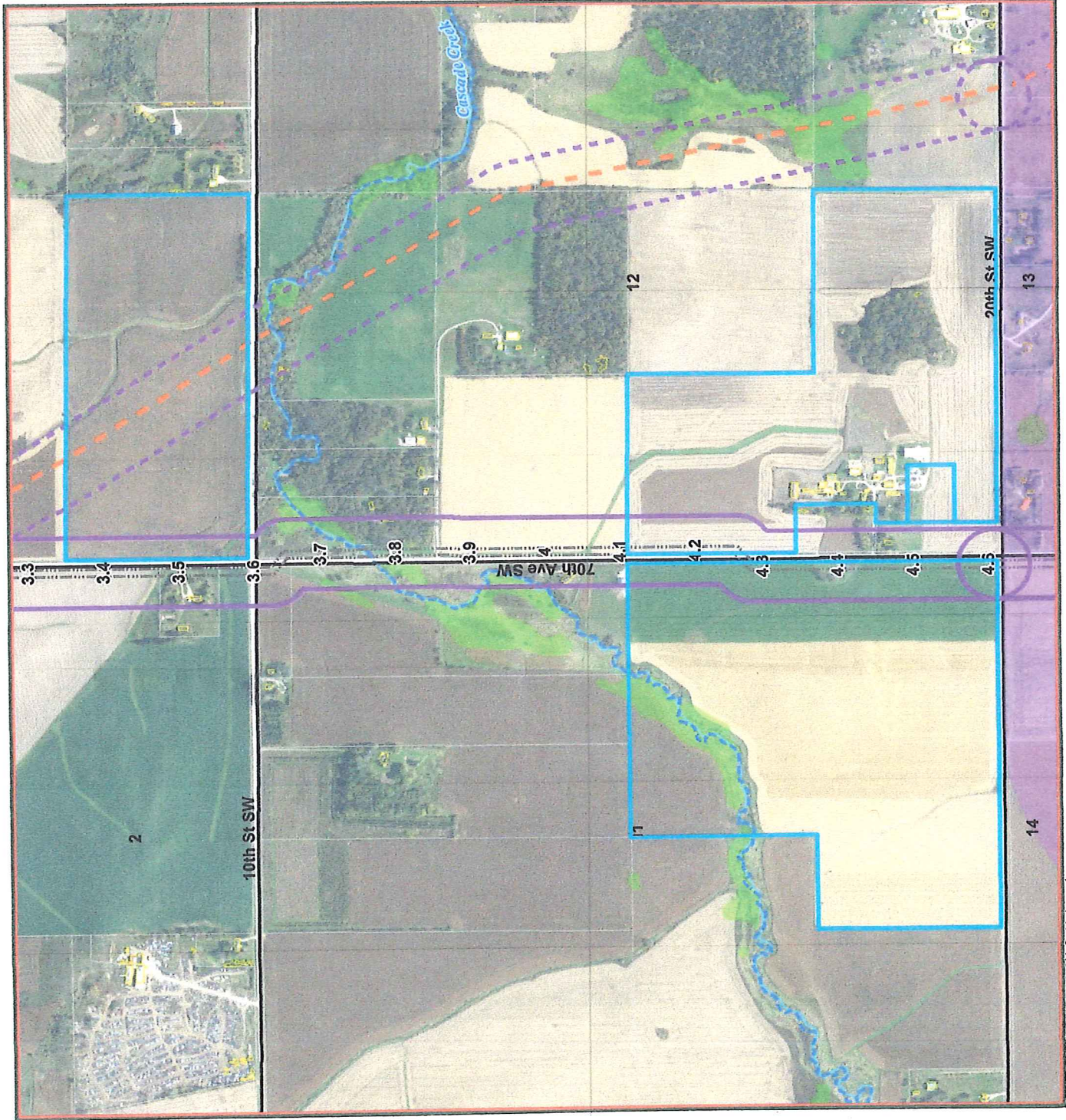
- What human and environmental impacts should be studied in the environmental analysis?
