The Administrative Law Judge filed Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Recommendation (ALJ Report) in the matters of Enbridge Energy's Certificate of Need and Route Permit applications for its proposed Line 3 Replacement Project. The ALJ Report is dated April 23, 2018, but was not filed in e-dockets or e-served on parties until April 24, 2018.

Pursuant to Minn. Stat. § 14.61, subd. 1, and Minn. R. 7829.2700, parties to these proceedings shall file and serve on the other parties any exceptions to the ALJ Report within 15 days of its filing because these proceedings are subject to statutory deadlines. Exceptions to the ALJ Report must be filed with the Commission and served on parties by **May 9, 2018**.
