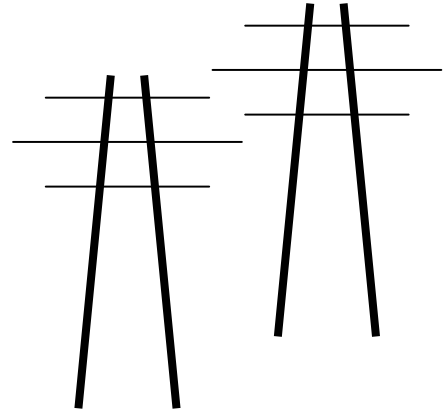

Dear Judge Newmark and Ms. Craft:

Today, in reviewing the DEIS, I saw that the Agricultural Impact Statement (AIS) in Exhibit G is just a summary. It states that an AIS “has been prepared” but I have learned that the full document is not yet complete. I have been told by Ms. Weiss that the full AIS will be filed with her testimony, but that is roughly two weeks after the deadline for comments on the EIS.

Intervenors and the public are unable to comment on the full AIS document without access.

The Agricultural Impact Statement is an integral part of environmental review, and is particularly important to intervenors with agricultural interests. Can these parts of environmental review be aligned, i.e., production of the full AIS and extension for DEIS comments, through an informal request, or is a Motion necessary?
