RE: COMPLIANCE FILING FREEBORN WIND SITE PERMIT DOCKET NO. IP-6946/WS-17-410

Dear Mr. Wolf:

Northern States Power Company, doing business as Xcel Energy, submits to the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission this compliance filing for the Freeborn Wind Energy project, in compliance with the Large Wind Energy Conversion System (LWECS) Site Permit Section 10.1, Pre-Construction Meeting.

This Pre-Construction filing is made for a singular phase of the wind farm project: project substation and O&M building site preparation (grading in a row crop agricultural field on land owned by Xcel Energy) and pouring of the concrete pad. Xcel Energy currently has an LWECS Site Permit Amendment application before the Commission and notes that an earlier LWECS Site Permit Amendment is currently the subject of an appeal in the Minnesota Court of Appeals; however, the project substation and O&M building, which are permitted, associated facilities in the original and current LWECS permit are not proposed to be changed in location nor design, and would be built as shown in these documents whether the permit amendment is approved or not, and are not within the scope of the appeal.

The same phased approach to construction was used for the Blazing Star 1 and 2 Wind Farm substation projects. The pre-construction documentation herein applies only to the substation and O&M building sites. Pre-construction documentation relative to turbine construction will be filed at a later date. Section 10.1 of the Site Permit states:

Prior to the start of any construction, the Permittee shall participate in a pre-construction meeting with the Department of Commerce and Commission staff to review pre-construction filing requirements, scheduling, and to coordinate monitoring of construction and site restoration activities. Within 14 days following the pre-construction meeting, the Permittee shall file with the Commission, a summary of the topics reviewed and discussed and a list of attendees. The Permittee shall indicate in the filing the construction start date.

Attachment A to this filing is the meeting summary.

- III. Review of Permit Compliance Filings Submitted to Date (DOC-EERA): Partial project construction, filings as they apply to the project substation and O&M building (November 8 filings):
 - Section 4.7: Native Prairie Protection Plan; filed a letter indicating per surveys no native prairie present at the substation nor O&M building site and that the NPPP will be filed ahead of the second pre-construction meeting. This is a long lead time item.
 - Section 5.2.1: Field Rep; Sean Lawler identified
 - Section 5.2.6: SWPPP
 - Section 5.2.10: Invasive Species; mostly agricultural, no major concerns
 - Section 5.2.12: Identification of Roads
 - Discussion of coordination between Sean Lawler and Sue Miller on developing route for this phase of construction.
 - EERA asked for clarification of road authorities for identification of roads used to access O&M and Substation site. Road for access to O&M and Substation is a Shell Rock Township road. Other roads to be used are County Roads.
 - Section 5.5.2: Other Permits
 - Approach Permit; Sue Miller has granted access to site based on Xcel's agreement to have one approach for each facility with two temporary approaches.
 - EERA would like to see confirmation of County approval to access Substation and O&M sites. Xcel has a Road Use Management Agreement signed by Freeborn County, and joined by Shell Rock Township via Resolution. Xcel intends to use an existing approach to the site near the intersection of 840th Avenue and County Road 1. This approach has been approved by Freeborn County.
 - Section 7.1: Biological & Natural Resources Inventories; 30-day filing for next pre-construction meeting; EERA has not been using full 30 days for disturbed sites like Freeborn
 - Section 9.0: Complaint Procedures
 - May 10, 2019 order says it will be updated after construction
 - Dan Litchfield listed as preconstruction contact; EERA would like another filing providing clarity on where communications should be directed. Xcel Energy is filing an updated Complaint Procedures document with the correct company contact information.
 - Section 10.1: Pre-con meeting; reference to notes in this section
 - Section 10.3: Site plan
 - Section 10.10: Emergency Response Plan; needs to be updated prior to preoperation meeting

 - EERA requested an update; can be put into the meeting minutes. Only include activities for this phase of construction.

 - Q1 2020: start shell of O&M building
 - Q2 2020: complete O&M and substation foundations; start of other project construction activities
