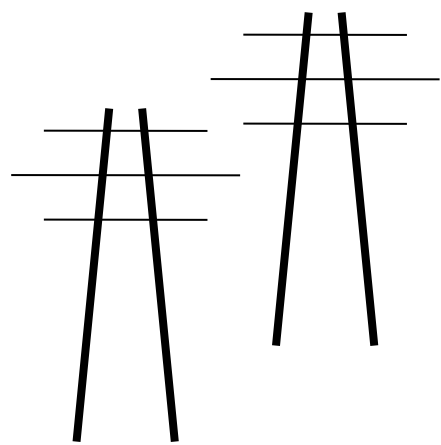

Dear Judge Newmark:

On behalf of Grant County Intervenors, I am responding to correspondence received from Ms. Polakowski, representing Grant County Solar, LLC regarding my client association Grant County Intervenors Petition for Intervention.

Grant County Intervenors reminds Grant County Solar, LLC that there is no requirement in rule or statute that an intervenor “provide specific information regarding its members.” This has been hashed over many times in Commission proceedings. There is no legitimate reason that “GCI promptly provide a current list of member names and addresses.”

Grant County Intervenors also reminds Grant County Solar, LLC that the issues of the proceeding are set at the Prehearing Conference and post-PHC Memorandum, and not before.

If you determine that these issues raised by GCS require a hearing, Grant County Intervenors request oral argument. If you have any questions, or require anything further, please let me know.
