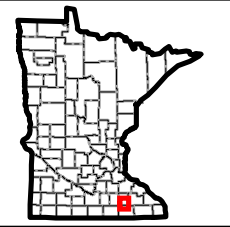
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Figure 1 - Proposed Transmission Route Map

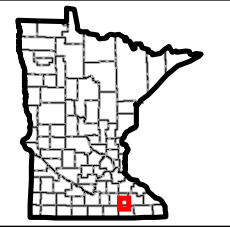
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Figure 1 - Proposed Transmission Route Map

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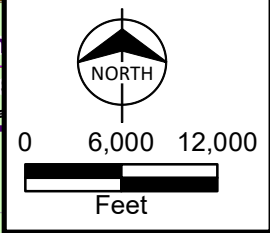
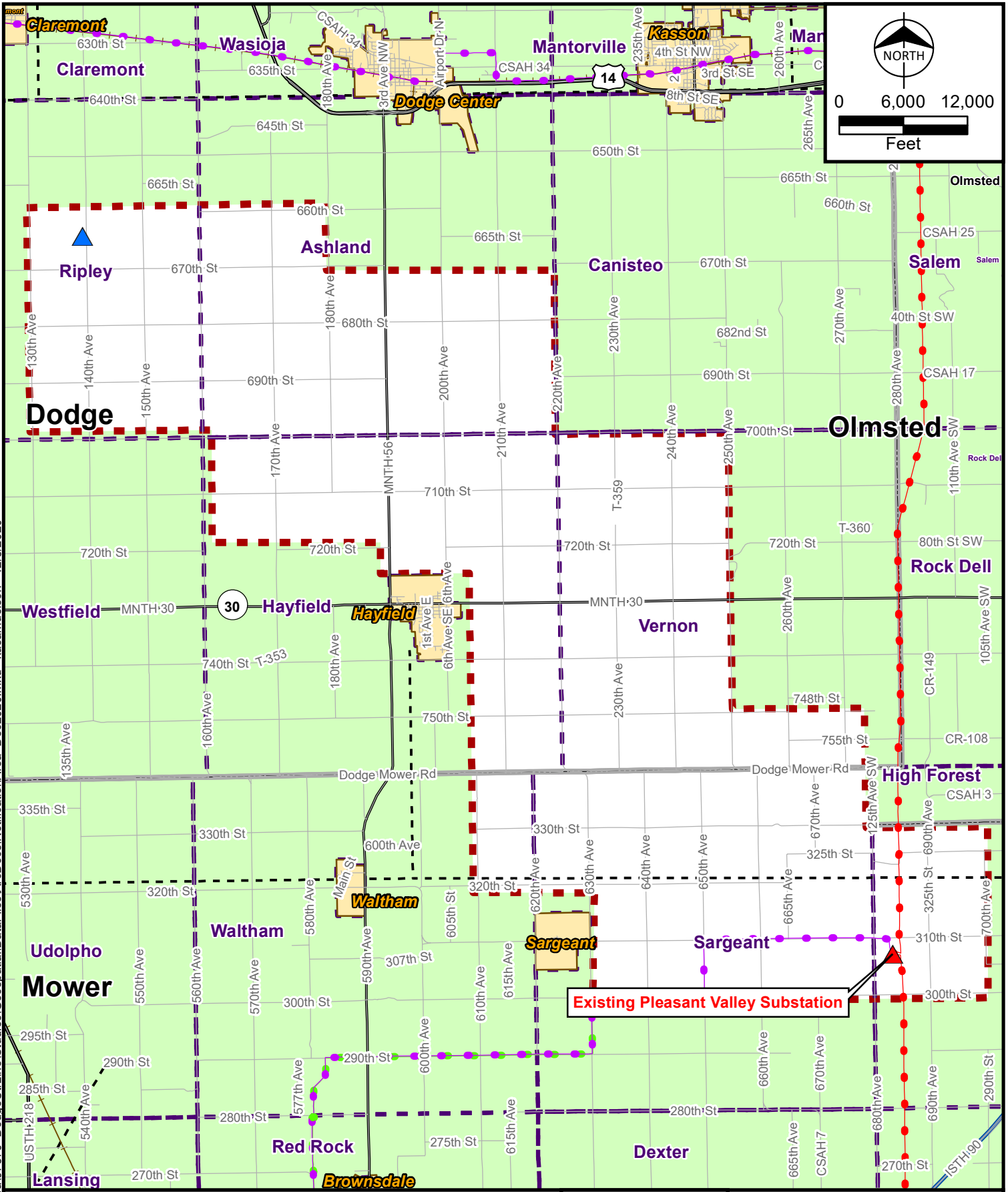
