NON-DISCLOSURE AGREEMENT

This Non-Disclosure Agreement (hereafter the "Agreement") is being made and entered into as of the date of the last required signature entered below, and is between Excelsior Energy Inc. a business corporation organized and operating under the laws of the State of Minnesota (herein referred to as "Excelsior") and the State of Minnesota, acting by and through its administrative agency known as the Office of the Commissioner of Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation (herein referred to as the "IRRRA").

EXCELSIOR proposes to disclose to the IRRRA certain information concerning its power generation needs, capabilities, and related energy system technology concepts which EXCELSIOR regards as confidential information. Such disclosure is being made by EXCELSIOR in regard to its potential application to the IRRRA for public financial assistance for its business enterprise and activities. Although the relevant energy generation system industry may be aware of certain information which EXCELSIOR regards and proposes to designate as confidential, EXCELSIOR believes and has informed the IRRRA that such relevant industry may not know that EXCELSIOR uses such information, or how EXCELSIOR uses such information. Although the relevant industry may generally know of various fragments of information which EXCELSIOR designates as confidential, it may not know how EXCELSIOR combines such information or what results EXCELSIOR intends to obtain from such combinations. Therefore, EXCELSIOR regards the information which it uses and in part proposes to make available to the IRRRA, as "confidential information" in the common usage of that term. Specifically, EXCELSIOR regards as confidential, without limitation:

- 1. All reading matter, all verbal discussions pertaining to/of EXCELSIOR, all technical papers, trade secrets, manufacturing, marketing, sales, cost, pricing and financial information of EXCELSIOR and its owner(s); and,
- 2. Proprietary processes and designs, inventions, formulas, technical drawings and data, research subjects, reports, methods and results, unpublished product specifications and characteristics, plans for future product development, potential facilities and sites, experimentation testing and results, technical information relating to combinations of existing technology to new products, marketing plans and strategies, pricing policies, and cost and profit information.

By this Agreement EXCELSIOR is seeking to obtain from the IRRRA assurances of that such information which EXCELSIOR provides to the IRRRA, when and as received by the IRRRA, will be used and treated by the IRRRA as confidential information to the maximum extent permitted by the Act (as defined below).

The IRRRA as a governmental entity of the State of Minnesota is subject to, and its actions in regard to information it receives and maintains are governed by, the provisions of the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act which is contained in Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 13 (as currently existing and as subsequently amended, the "Act"). Under the Act, the term "Government Data" means and includes all data collected, created, received, maintained or disseminated by a state agency such as

the IRRRA regardless of its physical form, storage media or conditions of uses. The Act provides that all Government Data is public unless otherwise classified as "Not Public Data". The term "Not Public Data" is defined by the Act as any government data which is classified by statute, federal law, or temporary classification as confidential, private, non public, or protected nonpublic. Various provisions within the Act classify various types of Government Data as "Not Public Data". EXCELSIOR understands that the IRRRA's ability to treat the data received by it from or on behalf of EXCELSIOR is controlled by and limited to the protections for such data afforded by and pursuant to the provisions of the Act. IRRRA agrees and commits that it will regard and treat all data received from EXCELSIOR as Not Public Data to the maximum extent permitted by the Act. The IRRRA further agrees and commits that it will promptly inform EXCELSIOR by written or facsimile notice as provided below of any request received by the IRRRA from any third party (party other than IRRRA or its agents, employees, or contractors) for disclosure of any Government Data received from or on behalf of EXCELSIOR and of the IRRRA's intended response to such request for data, and will not furnish any such data to the requesting party sooner than the fifth (5th) State business day following its receipt of such request in order to afford Excelsior time to institute legal actions to protect or prevent the disclosure of such requested data.

Notwithstanding any of the above provisions, the IRRRA will not be responsible for regarding as Not Public Data any EXCELSIOR information which:

- 1. is in the IRRRA's possession prior to receipt thereof from EXCELSIOR (which fact of prior possession must be proved by documents prepared prior to the date of disclosure of such information by EXCELSIOR); or
- 2. is in the public domain or enters the public domain at the time of disclosure through no act or failure to act by the IRRRA; or
- 3. following disclosure, becomes generally known or available through no act or mission on the part of the IRRRA; or
- 4. is known or becomes known to the IRRRA from a source other than Excelsior or its representatives, provided that disclosure by such source is not in breach of a confidentiality agreement with Excelsior; or
- 5. is independently developed by the IRRRA without violating any of its obligations under this Agreement; or
- 6. is lawfully disclosed by the IRRRA to any third party as a matter of right and without restriction, including any disclosures of such EXCELSIOR information required by the Act or made in response to any judicial order or governmental directive (other than a directive by an official of the IRRRA which is not mandated by the provisions of the Act).

EXCELSIOR will mark all materials which it furnishes to the IRRRA which it regards as confidential with the words "Information Regarded as Confidential by EXCELSIOR", and the IRRRA will retain such words on any copies of any such materials made by IRRRA for its use. The IRRRA understands and agrees that EXCELSIOR by disclosing to the IRRRA the information which it regards as confidential is not granting the IRRRA any license or rights to use such information under any patent, trademark copyright or other proprietary right of EXCELSIOR.

IRRRA agrees that, upon EXCELSIOR's request received prior to submission of EXCELSIOR's request for financial assistance to the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board (the "Board"), it will promptly, to the extent permitted under Minnesota law, return to EXCELSIOR all copies in whatever form received from EXCELSIOR of the information which EXCELSIOR regards as confidential that may then be in the IRRRA's possession or under the IRRRA's control.

Unless otherwise specifically provided herein, all notices shall be in writing addressed to the respective party as set forth below and may be personally served, telecopied or sent by overnight courier service or United States mail and shall be deemed to have been given:

- 1. if delivered in person, when delivered;
- 2. if delivered by telecopy, on the date of transmission (with confirmation of receipt) if transmitted on a State Business Day (weekdays other than Saturday or Sunday or Minnesota legal holidays) before 4:00 p.m. Central time or, if not, on the next succeeding State Business Day;
- 3. if delivered by overnight courier with instructions to deliver on the next State Business Day, on the State Business Day after delivery to such courier properly addressed; or
- 4. if by U.S. Mail, four (4) days after depositing in the United States mail, with postage for certified mail, return receipt requested, prepaid and properly addressed;

I am writing in response to Than Tibbets's December 6, 2006 request for copies of the full invoices of various consultants to Excelsior Energy.

Under Minnesota Statutes § 13.37 Subd. 1(b), the information that Mr. Tibbets is requesting constitutes "trade secret information" and is therefore "nonpublic data" under Minnesota Statutes § 13.02 Subd. 9. Consequently, that information is not accessible to the public under applicable Minnesota law.

Minnesota Statutes § 13.37 Subd. 1(b) applies for two primary reasons. First, Excelsior consistently maintains the secrecy of the information in those documents. Second, Excelsior derives independent economic value from that information not being known to, and not being readily ascertainable by proper means by, other persons who can obtain economic value from its disclosure or use.

Additionally, the information contained in the invoices that Mr. Tibbets is requesting would reveal portions of Excelsior's business plan. Consequently, the data is "nonpublic" under Minnesota Statutes § 13.591 Subd. 2, and it is therefore not available to the public.
