This information, instruction, or edict shall be read to the Klansmen in open klavern for the next six successive meetings of your Klan, so that all who hear may know and govern themselves accordingly.

Atlanta, Ga .- Philip E. Fox is under arrest here for the murder of W. S. Coburn, who was shot in his law office here this week. Fox is said to have been editor of a Klan publication, while Lawyer Coburn represented the disgruntled Klansmen who were defeated in litigation in which they sought to attack the management of Klan affairs.

Peace warrants against three high Klan officials were dismissed when the complaining witness failed to appear in court. Dr. Fred B. Johnson swore to complaints against four Klan officials, claiming that he feared for his life. The warrants were served on three men, but the fourth man was out of the city and the warrant for him was not served.

Klan officials claim that Dr. Johnson's motive in filing the complaints was to foster strife within the Klan, Dr. Linton Smith, family physician for Fox, examined the prisoner for possible mental disorders in view of the man's queer actions of late.
