Resolutions

WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of this, the New Ulm Provisional Klan No. 29, Realm of Minnesota, Knights of the Ku Klux Klan, that certain sectarian organizations are disseminating a species of sectarian propaganda which unfairly and unjustly seeks to convert public opinion towards establishing a figure in world

WHEREAS, the Roman Catholic hierarchy claims the sole right and divine jurisdiction over the Western Hemisphere, because of this alleged discovery, as is proven in the Encyclical Letter of Pope Leo XIII, given at St. Peter's, Rome, on the 25th day of December, 1891, in the 15th year of pontificate, wherein is stated, that "The American Republic under Protestant rulers is with the worst enemies of the Church; this Republic having seized upon the lands discovered by Christopher Columbus, a Catholic, and usurped the authority and jurisdiction of the supreme head of

WHEREAS, all historians maintain doubt as to Columbus having ever set foot on North America, many claiming that he died entirely ignorant of the existence of the mainland; that Columbus was in a sense a discoverer possibly, in so far that he reached a West Indian island, which was named San Salvador in the year 1492, but that this alleged discovery was purely accidental, as he had originally set out to sail for India, where gold and riches were the lure, while some historians on the other hand claim that he had prior knowledge of the existence of a new world from the archieves of the vatican, where information and learning of every sort were carefully filed, recording the Norse discovery of Vineland and of the voyages of the Vikings to our shores; that this previous knowledge which Columbus had at his disposal gave him that extraordinary confidence, which the romantic accounts of his voyage to San Salvador are ascribed to his "enlightenment from heaven," and

WHEREAS, fair and unbiased history records that to Leif Ericson is due the honor of discovery of the American continent in the year 1000, five centuries previous to the alleged discovery of America by Columbus, that Ericson in his explorations touched three peninsulas-Newfoundland, Nova Scotia, and Cape Cod, building his house and passing the winter near the latter on the mainland, which he called Vineland (now Massachusetts), that he made known his discovery, and described the character of the new land, upon his return to Greenland the following year, and

WHEREAS, and further, if any man is to be honored by the American people as discoverer of America ,the honor should go to Leif Ericson, and to him only, and

BE IT RESOLVED, that we go on record as deploring the insidious propaganda beging promoted in our schools and through the public press, by exalting and extelling Christopher Columbus as the discoverer of America, and we further deplore and resent the action of any local sectarian organizations proclaiming through paid advertisements in the press that October 12th, designated by such organizations as Columbus Day, such day to be commemorated because of this alleged "discovery of our great land," and we further resent the false claim that the Western Hemisphere is under the sole and divine jurisdiction of the papacy due to the alleged discovery of America by a Catholic, calling attention to the fact that Leif Ericson, of Nordic stock, from which the Anglo-Saxon race was developed, was the real discoverer of America-particularly the United States that our country was colonized by Protestant Pilgrims, that it was given birth as a Christian nation, by a Protestant Washington, and its unity was preserved by a Protestant Lincoln, and further be it

The Grand Master of B'rith Abraham announced at a recent convention that Jews were proud to join with their "Catholic brethren" in making war on an American order. During the Michigan school amendment fight, Bishop Michael Gallagher, evidencing supreme confidence in Jewish friendship, appeared before the B'nai B'rith, asking that body to vote with the Papists against the amendment. A Jewish delegate thereupon arose, and suggested that, in exchange for their 50,000 votes, the Bishop should use his influence to stop Polish pogroms. There was evidently no doubt in the minds of those Jews where the responsibility for the pogroms lay, nor did they fail to recognize the necessity for a neat bargain!

In the last convention of the B'nai B'rith at Saratoga, 200 delegates KELLOGG'S FORMER greeted with uproarious shouts the Catholic Al Smith, present "wet" Governor of New York, hailing him as "out next President;" and now Jews have joined a fraternal organization with Catholics and Negroes to fight the Klan and its large percentage of Masonic members.

The attitude of American Jews upon the question of immigration has, more than any other one thing, laid their Americanism under suspicion. In all their conventions they have gone on record as opposing restricted immigration, and have even called upon Congress to change the present regulations for their benefit, declaring the 3 per cent quota law to be "unfair and un-American." The American Jewish Congress in its last week's session, took up this immigration question with President Coolidge.

Just here an illustration: You adopt as a member of your family a youth who comes from poverty, persecution, and wretchedness. His religion is Mohammedan, and he is accorded every family privilege, and the right to worship God according to the dictates of his own conscience, but the house which you have builded, and the family you have founded, continue with their own religion and customs.

Gradually, as the memories of past horrors grow dim, the Mohammedan presumes to demand that the whole machinery of family life and government shall be changed to conform with his ideas. He must hear no mention of the Christ in prayer; the Koran is supreme authority; even the family diet must be made conformable to the schedule of his feasts and fasts; and, should his benefactor desire guests, they must be Oriental Mohammedans.

This is the precise attitude of Jewry today, with a never-ending plea for special privilege.

The man always looking for and anticipating slights and unkindness is tacitly admitting inferiority; and the I-am-as-good-as-you attitude is ever that of the underling. So if, after all these years of American good will and opporunity, the Jew still deems himself persecuted, let him turn his gaze inward, and scan the hidden recesses of his own heart, for it cannot be that he has been unfailingly right, and all the nations of the earth wrong.

And then, having searched, if he discover naught of elemental weakness within his own spiritual fibre, and still lays blame for every mischance upon outside causes, there are lands beyond the sea where the inestimable privileges of Papal rule and customs may be enjoyed, and, at any time, he may shake off the contamination of American dust and American dollars, and fare forth. For be it known to all those who cannot hereafter assimilate American

ideals, forgetting the group spirit, and joining heart and soul with the soul of America, that the hour has struck upon the dial plate of time when they may no longer look to the ruling and regulating of Anglo-Saxon America, for the sceptre shall depart from Judah, and the reins of power fall from the palsied fingers of ecclesiastical and political aliens.
