ORDER DENYING THE WORLD ORGANIZATION FOR LANDOWNER FREEDOM'S MOTION TO CERTIFY ITS PETITION TO INTERVENE

In the Matter of the Application of Minnesota Power for a Route Permit for a High Voltage Transmission Line for the HVDC Modernization Project in Hermantown, Saint Louis County.

On January 27, 2024, the World Organization for Landowner Freedom (W.O.L.F.), a non-stock corporation from Hawkins, Wisconsin, filed a Motion for Certification of Administrative Law Judge Jim Mortenson's denial of W.O.L.F.'s petition for intervention (Motion). On February 6, 2024, American Transmission Company, LLC (ATC), filed a letter objecting to W.O.L.F.'s request for certification.

Carol A. Overland, Legalectric – Overland Law Office, appeared on behalf of W.O.L.F. Eric F. Swanson, Winthrop & Weinstine, P.A., appeared on behalf of ATC.

Pursuant to Minn. R. 1400.5500, .7600 (2023), and for the reasons explained below.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED,

W.O.L.F.'s Motion is **DENIED**.

MEMORANDUM

W.O.L.F. requests certification of the denial of its Petition to Intervene to the Public Utilities Commission.¹ W.O.L.F. wants to be a party because it wants to preserve the requirement that the substation in involved in the HVDC Modernization Project (Project) be limited to 800 megavolt-amperes (MVA).² W.O.L.F. wants to be sure it may "inform the record in this proceeding."³

Minn. R. 1400.7600 sets forth the standards for certifying a motion to an agency when a contested case is pending before an administrative law judge. The rule specifically excludes "rulings on the admissibility of evidence or interpretations of parts 1400.5100 to 1400.8400" from being certifiable questions.⁴

The decision denying W.O.L.F.'s Petition to Intervene was based on Minn. R. 1400.5500 and .6200 (2023). Therefore, the denial of the Petition is not eligible for certification. Moreover, the denial of the Petition did not deprive W.O.L.F. the opportunity to participate as a member of the public in the contested case, pursuant to Minn. R. 1400.6200, subp. 5, .7150 (2023), and 1405.0800 (2023), or from informally collaborating with and supporting other parties. Specifically, W.O.L.F. may file offer direct testimony in written form at or following the hearing and may cross-examine witnesses by submitting questions in writing to the Administrative Law Judge to ask them before or during the hearings.

In fact, the decision turned on the fact the Judge could not determine what W.O.L.F.'s "legal rights are, what its duties are, or what privileges it has, which it seeks to protect" as a result of its failure to more clearly identify itself. Merely providing a link to the State of Wisconsin's website showing W.O.L.F. is a non-stock corporation out of a small town in north-central Wisconsin sheds little light on who or what it is, regardless of what it has done in the past. *See*, Order Denying the World Organization for Landowner Freedom's Petition to Intervene as a Full Party at 3 (Jan. 22, 2024).
