NOTICE OF COMMENT PERIOD ON REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION FROM CERTAIN CERTIFICATE OF NEED APPLICATION CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

In the Matter of the Application for a Certificate of Need for the Bison to Alexandria Second Circuit 345 kV Transmission Line Project.

PUC Docket Number: E002, ET2, E015, E017, ET6135/CN-25-116

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) is accepting comments on Northern States Power Company, doing business as Xcel Energy, Great River Energy, Minnesota Power, Otter Tail Power Company, and Western Minnesota Municipal Power Agency (collectively, the Applicants) request for exemptions from certain certificate of need information requirements for the certificate of need application for the Bison – Alexandria 345 kilovolt (kV) Transmission Project (Project).

The Project would involve adding a new 345 kV transmission circuit on existing double-circuit capable transmission line structures from the existing Bison Substation near Fargo, North Dakota to the existing Alexandria Substation near Alexandria, Minnesota. The proposed 345 kV transmission line will traverse Wilkin, Otter Tail, Grant, Douglas, and Clay counties.

Comment Period: Initial comment period closes September 19, 2025, at 4:30 p.m.

Reply comment period closes September 26, 2025, at 4:30 p.m.

Supplemental comment period closes October 3, 2025, at 4:30 p.m.

Comments received after the close of the comment period may or may not be considered by the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission.
