

NOTICE OF COMMENT PERIOD ON REQUEST FOR EXEMPTION FROM CERTAIN CERTIFICATE OF NEED APPLICATION CONTENT REQUIREMENTS

In the Matter of the Application for a Certificate of Need for the Maple River to Cuyuna 345 kV Transmission Line Project.

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) is accepting comments on Minnesota Power, Great River Energy, and Otter Tail Power Company (collectively, the Applicants) request for exemptions from certain information requirements for a certificate of need application for the Maple River – Cuyuna 345 kV Transmission Project (Project).

The Project would involve construction of a new 345 kV single-circuit transmission line, on double-circuit capable structures, connecting Minnesota Power's Cuyuna Substation in Crow Wing County to Otter Tail Power Company's Maple River Substation near Fargo, North Dakota.

Comment Period: Initial comment period closes September 16, 2025, at 4:30 p.m.

Reply comment period closes October 6, 2025, at 4:30 p.m.

Supplemental comment period closes October 13, 2025, at 4:30 p.m.

Comments received after the close of the comment period may or may not be considered by the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission.
