**NOTICE PLAN PETITION**

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**I. INTRODUCTION & BACKGROUND**

Dairyland Power Cooperative (Dairyland) and Northern States Power Company, doing business as Xcel Energy (together, Applicants), respectfully submit this Notice Plan for approval by the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) pursuant to Minn. R. 7829.2550.

The North Rochester – Columbia 765 kilovolt (kV) Transmission Line Project (Project) is part of the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc.’s (MISO) Long Range Transmission Planning (LRTP) Tranche 2.1 and is needed to maintain system reliability amid fundamental changes in demand for electricity and the type and amount of generation interconnected to the grid within the MISO footprint. The Project is proposed to include the following facilities in Minnesota:

- A single-circuit 765 kV high voltage transmission line between the existing North Rochester Substation<sup>1</sup> and a point near Marion, Minnesota;

- A 765 kV/161 kV double-circuit high voltage transmission line from near Marion, Minnesota, to the Wisconsin border; and
- A new three-circuit breaker 161 kV switching station in Houston County, Minnesota; a specific location has not yet been identified. The 161 kV switching station will connect to two existing 161 kV transmission lines from Harmony, Minnesota, and Lansing, Iowa, and an existing single-circuit 161 kV line between the new switching station and the existing Genoa Substation in Wisconsin.

The Project is the Minnesota portion of LRTP No. 26 and, with the other Tranche 2.1 projects, will establish a new 765 kV “backbone” across the Midwest, making Minnesota’s connection to the broader Midwest and eastern United States more robust and resilient, enabling Minnesota and the region to meet electrical demand in a more reliable and cost-effective manner.

Applicants intend to file an Application for a Certificate of Need (Application) for the Project in February 2026, and a route permit application later in 2026. The initial step in the Certificate of Need Application process is approval of a Notice Plan to be implemented by the Applicants. Through implementation of the Notice Plan, potentially interested persons will be notified of the opportunity to participate in the regulatory process.

## **II. DEVELOPMENT OF PROPOSED NOTICE AREA**

Applicants have developed a proposed Notice Area to identify areas reasonably likely to be affected by the Project. As described in more detail below, Applicants first identified a “Study Area” and then refined the Study Area before finalizing the Notice Area proposed here.

In developing the Study Area, Applicants determined that the Notice Area needed to be large enough to encompass multiple routing corridors and identified primary routing constraints and criteria. These constraints/criteria included the Commission’s routing criteria , municipalities, Tribal and federal land, existing corridors, and the Project’s connection to the existing North Rochester Substation and its crossing of the Wisconsin/Minnesota border.

Next, Applicants refined the Study Area to exclude from the proposed Notice Area portions of counties where routing was unlikely—for example, areas where routing is unlikely due to the Project’s geographic requirements. With some exceptions identified in Table 1 below , Applicants have also excluded municipalities with populations exceeding 200 from the proposed Notice Area because routing the Project within such municipalities is unlikely.<sup>2</sup> However, in certain instances, Applicants included discrete portions of municipalities within the proposed Notice Area if there were potential routing opportunities that could be considered for Project routing in those areas.

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<sup>2</sup> As such, residents/owners within these municipalities would not receive direct mail notice. Applicants would nonetheless provide mail notice to local government officials and publish newspaper notice in these areas, as described in Section V below. This approach is generally consistent with the Notice Plan Petition in Docket No. E002/CN-06-1115.

As a result of the analysis described above, the Applicants propose the Notice Area depicted on [Attachment 1](#). Generally moving from northwest to southeast, the proposed Notice Area includes all or portions of the following counties: Goodhue, Wabasha, Olmsted, Mower, Fillmore, and Houston.

The proposed Notice Area is broad enough to encompass likely routing corridors, but excludes areas where future routing is unlikely, either because of the presence of routing constraints, and/or because of the Project's geographic requirements. Thus, Applicants respectfully submit that the proposed Notice Area is inclusive of areas reasonably likely to be affected by the Project.

### **III. NOTICE PLAN PROPOSAL**

As discussed in more detail below, Applicants' Notice Plan consists of four parts:

- Direct mail notice to landowners reasonably likely to be affected by the Project;
- Direct mail notice to others with mailing addresses within the area reasonably likely to be affected by the Project;

- Direct mail notice to tribal governments and to the governments of towns, cities, and counties whose jurisdictions are reasonably likely to be affected by the Project; and
- Newspaper notice to members of the public in areas reasonably likely to be affected by the Project.

Included with this filing are examples of the notices Applicants propose to mail (Attachment 2) and publish (Attachment 3).

#### **A. Proposed Notice Area**

Applicants propose to provide notice within the proposed Notice Area depicted on Attachment 1. The Applicants' development of the proposed Notice Area is discussed in Section II, above. For the reasons identified there, Applicants respectfully submit that the proposed Notice Area is of an appropriate scope to provide notice to stakeholders who may be reasonably likely to be affected by the Project.

#### **B. Direct Mail Notice to Landowners**

Minn. R. 7829.2550, Subp. 3(A) requires that direct mail notice be provided to "landowners reasonably likely to be affected by the proposed transmission line." As required by Minn. R. 7829.2550, Subp. 3(A), Applicants will review and use county tax assessment rolls where available. Applicants will also review the Minnesota Geospatial Commons administered by the State of Minnesota, as available, and/or ReportAll USA to determine the names and addresses of those landowners who own property within the proposed Notice Area.

As described in Section II above, with the exceptions noted in Table 1, Applicants propose to exclude landowners within municipalities with populations exceeding 200 from this portion of the Notice Plan because routing within those municipalities is unlikely. Applicants will nonetheless provide notice to local government officials and publish newspaper notice, as described in paragraphs (D) and (E) below.

#### **C. Direct Mail Notice to Mailing Addresses**

Minn. R. 7829.2550, Subp. 3(B) requires that direct mail notice be provided to "all mailing addresses within the area reasonably likely to be affected by the proposed transmission line." Applicants intend to mail notice to all mailing addresses within the proposed Notice Area. The addresses will be gathered from mailing lists maintained by the United States Post Office or from bulk mailing firms. To reduce duplication, Applicants intend to merge the landowner mailing list, as discussed in paragraph (B), and this mailing address mailing list, and will send notification letters to those persons on the resulting list.

As described in Section II above, with the exceptions noted in Table 1, Applicants propose to exclude mailing addresses within municipalities with populations exceeding 200 from this portion of the Notice Plan because routing within those municipalities is unlikely. Applicants will nonetheless provide notice to local government officials and publish newspaper notice, as described in paragraphs (D) and (E) below.

#### **D. Direct Mail Notice to Local Governments**

Minn. R. 7829.2550, Subp. 3(C) requires that direct mail notice be provided to “tribal governments and to the governments of towns, statutory cities, home rule charter cities, and counties whose jurisdictions are reasonably likely to be affected by the proposed transmission line.”

With respect to Tribal Nations, Applicants propose to provide direct mail notice to all Tribal Nations within Minnesota. In addition, Applicants propose to send notice to Tribal Nations with an interest within the proposed Notice Area, but which may be located outside the State of Minnesota in accordance with the Commission’s July 2025 “Guidance for successful Tribal engagement” document. A preliminary mailing list is included as Attachment 4 and research is ongoing to identify any additional Tribal Nations with an interest within the proposed Notice Area.<sup>3</sup>

With respect to local governments, Applicants propose to provide direct mail notice to all the towns, cities, and counties within the exterior boundary of the proposed Notice Area, as reflected on the mailing list included as Attachment 5. For these local governments, Applicants propose to provide direct mail notice to each member of a county board and the county clerk; city mayor and city clerk; and township chair and township clerk. This list includes all municipalities within the proposed Notice Area (even those where Applicants are not proposing to send direct mail notice to landowners or individual mailing addresses within the municipality).

#### **E. Newspaper Notice**

Minn. R. 7829.2550, Subp. 3(D), requires that notice via newspapers be given to “members of the public in areas reasonably likely to be affected by the proposed transmission line.” Applicants propose to publish notice in the local newspapers identified in Attachment 6, which includes the newspaper of record in each county within the proposed Notice Area, as well as additional newspapers Applicants have identified in which publication would be useful to notify the public of the Project.

In addition to the Notice Plan newspaper notice requirement, Minn. R. 7829.2500, Subp. 5, requires that, after a Certificate of Need application is filed, an applicant publish newspaper notice of the filing in a newspaper of general circulation throughout the state. Here, Applicants propose to publish newspaper notice of the Certificate of Need proceeding shortly before the CN Application is filed in newspapers of local, regional, and statewide circulation. Because Applicants propose to publish a notice shortly before filing, Applicants request a variance of Minn. R. 7829.2500, Subp. 5, to remove the additional newspaper notice requirement to publish notice in a statewide newspaper shortly after the CN Application is submitted.

The Commission shall grant a variance pursuant to Minn. R. 7829.3200 when it determines that the following requirements are met:

- A. enforcement of the rule would impose an excessive burden upon the applicant or others affected by the rule;
- B. granting the variance would not adversely affect the public interest; and
- C. granting the variance would not conflict with standards imposed by law.

Here, all three factors are met. The rule would be an excessive burden because it requires duplicate notice and associated expense without a corresponding benefit. The public will be notified by notices in other newspapers and therefore the public interest would not be adversely affected. Granting the variance would not conflict with any legal standards. Accordingly, Applicants respectfully submit that a variance is warranted, consistent with prior Commission decisions.<sup>4</sup>

#### **F. Notice Content**

Minn. R. 7829.2550, Subp. 4, identifies the information that must be included in the notices. The Applicants have incorporated the required information into draft direct mail notice letters and a newspaper ad copy, examples of which are enclosed as Attachments 2 and 3. A copy of the map in Attachment 1 which depicts the proposed Notice Area will be provided with each direct mail notice letter and within the published notice.

#### **G. Distribution of Notice Plan Filing**

As required by Minn. R. 7829.2550, Subp. 1, Applicants will serve copies of this notice plan filing on the Department of Commerce, the Residential and Small Business Utilities Division of the Office of the Attorney General, and all persons on the “General List of Persons Interested in Power Plants and Transmission Lines” (*see* enclosed Certificate of Service).

#### **H. Notice Timing**

Minn. R. 7829.2550, subp. 6, requires the applicant to implement the Notice Plan within 30 days of its approval by the Commission. Applicants request that the Commission vary the Notice Plan implementation rule requirement to allow Applicants to provide the notices identified in this Notice Plan no more than 60 days and no less than one week prior to the filing of the Application. The three requirements for a rule variance under Minn. R. 7829.3200, subp. 1 are met: (1) enforcement of the rule would impose an excessive burden upon the applicant or others affected by the rule; (2) granting the variance would not adversely affect the public interest; and (3) granting the variance would not conflict with standards imposed by law. Applicants

respectfully submit these requirements are met here. First, the mailing lists related to this Notice Plan will be extensive, and varying this timing requirement ensures that Applicants have sufficient time to complete the notice after the Notice Plan Petition is approved. Similarly, varying the timing requirement ensures that members of the public will receive notice relatively close in time to the filing of the Application, which should reduce confusion and enhance public participation. Further, varying this timing requirement does not conflict with any other law. The Commission has previously granted the same requested variance in other Certificate of Need dockets.<sup>5</sup>

#### **I. Compliance Filing**

After implementing the Notice Plan, Applicants will then prepare and submit to the Commission a filing showing compliance with the Notice Plan. The compliance filing will provide sample copies of the materials distributed, copies of Affidavits of Publication, and copies of Affidavits of Service with accompanying lists of landowners/residents and local officials receiving direct mail notice letters.

#### **IV. CONCLUSION**

Applicants respectfully request that the Commission approve this Notice Plan submitted in preparation for filing a Certificate of Need Application for the Project.

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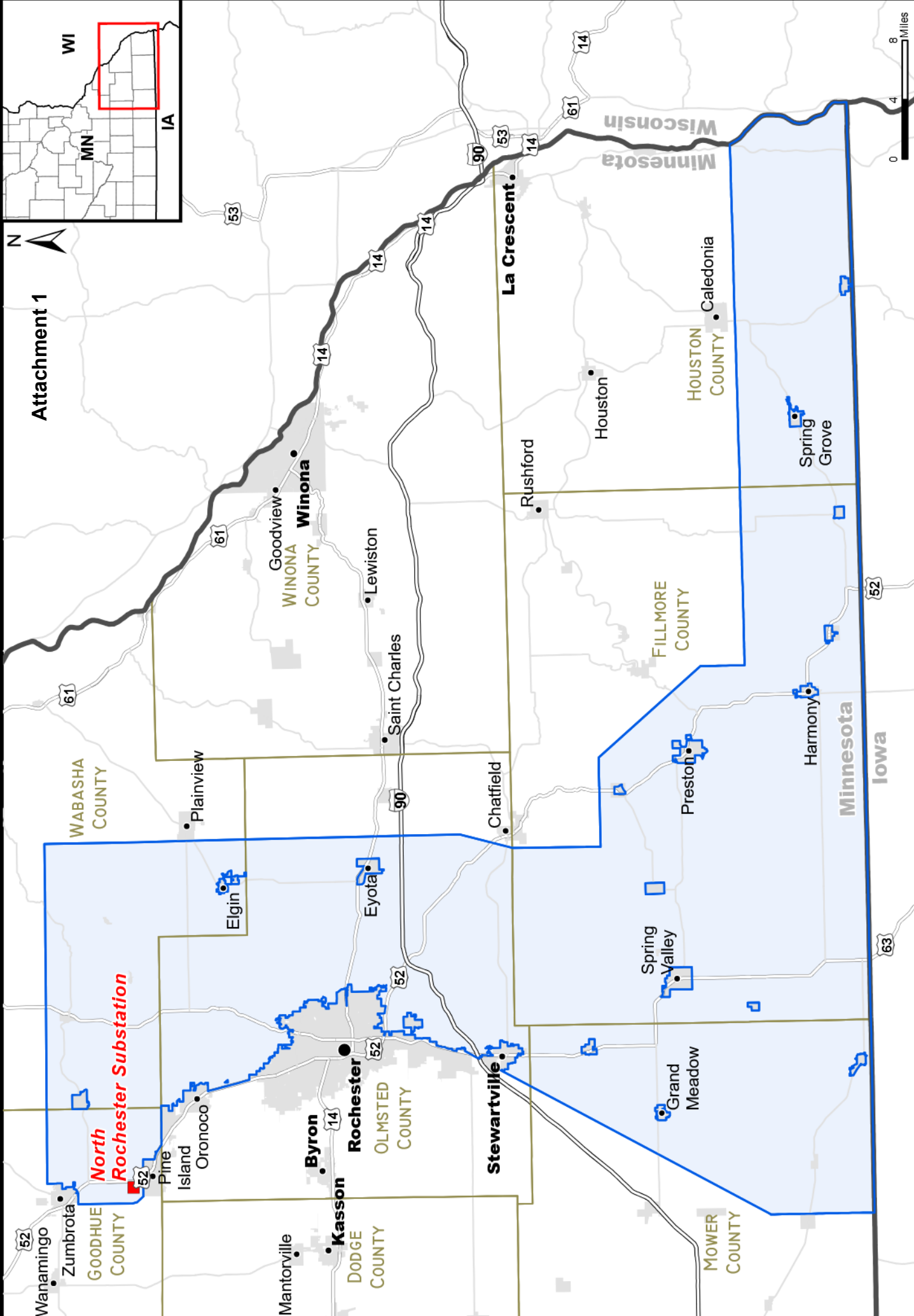

**RE: Notice of Certificate of Need Application for the North Rochester – Columbia 765 kV Transmission Project LRTP 26  
MPUC Docket No. 25-121**

Dairyland Power Cooperative (Dairyland) and Northern States Power Company, doing business as Xcel Energy (together, Applicants) are proposing the North Rochester – Columbia 765 kilovolt (kV) Transmission Project in Minnesota (Project). You are receiving this notice because you are: a landowner with property in the notice area; a resident within the notice area; a local unit of government within the notice area; or a Tribal official. This notice provides information about the Project and the state of Minnesota's permitting process.

Applicants are providing this notice of the Project at a very early stage of the development process. We want to provide those who may be affected with every opportunity to participate in meetings and hearings to come. At this stage of Project development, routes have not been identified for the Project. Instead, Applicants are providing broader notice to stakeholders within all or portions of the following counties: Goodhue, Wabasha, Olmsted, Mower, Fillmore, and Houston. In the end, many of those receiving this notice will not be directly affected. Nonetheless, we hope that you will take the time to participate in the regulatory process.

**Project Description**

The Project includes:

- A single-circuit 765 kV high voltage transmission line between the existing North Rochester Substation (to be called the Middle Fork Substation)<sup>1</sup> and a point near Marion, Minnesota;
- A 765 kV/161 kV double-circuit high voltage transmission line from near Marion, Minnesota, to the Wisconsin border; and
- A new three-circuit breaker 161 kV switching station in Houston County, Minnesota; a specific location has not yet been identified. The 161 kV switching station will connect to two existing 161 kV transmission lines from Harmony, Minnesota, and Lansing, Iowa, and an existing single-circuit 161 kV line between the new switching station and the existing Genoa Substation in Wisconsin.

Before beginning construction, Applicants will acquire property rights for the Project, typically through an easement that will be negotiated with the landowner for each parcel, and purchases in

fee for any substations. For this Project, Applicants anticipate acquiring easements with a right-of-way of up to approximately 250 feet wide.

### **Project Need**

The Project is part of the Midcontinent Independent System Operator, Inc.'s (MISO) Long Range Transmission Planning (LRTP) Tranche 2.1 set of transmission line projects, and is needed to maintain system reliability amid fundamental changes in demand for electricity and the type and amount of generation interconnected to the grid within the MISO footprint. The Project in combination with the other Tranche 2.1 projects will create a backbone connection in Minnesota that will ultimately be interconnected with the existing 765 kV network in the eastern United States. This network will make Minnesota's connection to the broader Midwest and eastern United States more robust and resilient, enabling Minnesota and the region to meet electrical demand in a more reliable and cost-effective manner. The Project is needed to continue to serve customer demand every minute of every day and to ensure a strong foundation that supports the resiliency of the grid.

### **Regulatory Process**

The Project requires two types of approvals from the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (MPUC or Commission): a Certificate of Need and a Route Permit. Applicants will submit a Certificate of Need Application for the Project to the Commission in February 2026. Separately, Applicants will also submit a Route Permit application to the Commission later in 2026. The Project cannot be constructed unless the Commission determines that it is needed in the Certificate of Need proceeding. In the Route Permit proceedings, the Commission will decide where the transmission line and other associated facilities will be located.

Applicants will seek a Certificate of Need from the Commission. The Certificate of Need process is governed by Minnesota law, including Minnesota Statutes section 216B.243, and Minnesota Rules Chapter 7849, specifically Rules parts 7849.0010 to 7849.0400 and 7849.1000 to 7849.2100. A copy of the Certificate of Need application, once submitted, can be obtained by visiting the Commission's website at [www.mn.gov/puc/](http://www.mn.gov/puc/) in Docket No. 25-121. The Commission will not make its determination on the Certificate of Need until it has completed a thorough review process that encourages public involvement and analyzes the need for the Project. This process includes the preparation of an Environmental Report (ER) for the Project by the Commission's Energy Infrastructure Permitting (EIP) staff.

Stakeholders will have an opportunity to submit comments and participate in the Certificate of Need process. You can get involved by submitting comments or attending public meetings and hearings. Please keep in mind that "need" issues should be raised in the Certificate of Need process, and issues concerning the location of the transmission line should be raised during the forthcoming Route Permit process. The table below provides a high-level summary of the major steps in the Certificate of Need process and Applicants' estimated dates for each step.

There will be a separate Route Permit application, and you will receive notices of those proceedings if you may be impacted by a proposed route.
