

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS AND  
AVAILABILITY OF DRAFT PERMIT**

Issued: August 31, 2026

**In the Matter of the Application of Xcel Energy and Echo Zone LLC for a Route Permit for the North Rochester to Skyway High Voltage Transmission Line Project in Goodhue County, Minnesota.**

**PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that the Minnesota Public Utilities Commission (Commission) will hold public hearings on the route permit application of Northern States Power Company, doing business as Xcel Energy, and Echo Zone LLC, a subsidiary of Google LLC (Applicants) for the North Rochester to Skyway 345 kilovolt (kV) Transmission Line Project (Project).

The Applicants propose to construct an approximately 1.2-mile long double-circuit 345 kV transmission line that would connect Xcel Energy's North Rochester Substation to four new substation facilities at the proposed Pine Island Industrial Planned Unit Development site. The Applicants also propose to expand the existing North Rochester Substation, currently on a footprint of 10 acres, by approximately 11.3 acres. The transmission line and North Rochester Substation expansion will be owned and operated by Xcel Energy and the four Project Skyway substations will be owned and operated by Google.

The Applicants have requested a route width of 1,000 feet for the transmission line, 500 feet on either side of the centerline, with an expanded route width around the North Rochester Substation and Project Skyway substations. The Applicants stated that the required right-of-way for the transmission line is 150 feet. Structures utilized for the project will be made of steel and range from 100 to 180 feet in height. Spans between structures will range from 150 to 975 feet. The Applicants propose to start construction in May 2027 with an in-service date of December 2029.

### Public Hearing Information

The public hearings will be presided over by the Honorable Kristien R.E. Butler, an administrative law judge with the Court of Administrative Hearings, who will provide the Commission with a summary of public testimony.

The purpose of the public hearings is to obtain public input on the proposed transmission line project and compile the record for the Commission to consider in making a final decision on the route permit application. Specifically, interested persons will have the opportunity to: (1) ask questions of state staff and the applicants; (2) offer oral and written comments on the merits of the proposed project; and (3) suggest possible changes to the draft permit, including revised or new conditions to be considered for inclusion in the route permit.

- Comments received at the hearings and during the comment period will be used to inform the record and help the Commission make its final decision.
- The presentations by Commission staff and the applicants will be the same at the in-person and online hearings.
- The hearings will end when all present attendees have had the opportunity to comment and all other business has been concluded, or at the scheduled end time of the hearing, whichever occurs first. **Accordingly, it is recommended that all interested persons arrive at the scheduled start time.**
- Members of the public may participate without the necessity of intervening as a party; representation by legal counsel is permitted but not required. Information regarding intervening as a party can be found on the Commission's website at: <https://mn.gov/puc/get-involved/how-to-intervene/>.

### Comment Period

Written comments will be accepted through **Friday, September 25, 2026, by 4:30 p.m.** Please include the docket number in all communications. Comments received after the close of the comment period may or may not be considered by the Commission.

The Applicants will file proposed findings of fact by October 2, 2026. Members of the public may comment on the Applicants' proposed findings of fact through **Friday, October 9, 2026, by 4:30 p.m.**

### **Draft Permit**

The Commission issued a draft route permit for the proposed North Rochester to Skyway HVTL project in accordance with Minnesota Statutes, chapter 216I on August 14, 2026. Interested parties may review the permit conditions that are being considered at this stage of the review process. Construction of the project is not authorized by a draft route permit. The Commission has the option to either modify the draft route permit in any way prior to its final issuance, or deny the permit.
